

- _____ Limits the power of the federal government to only those specifically granted to it by the constitution.
- _____ Prohibits the denial of suffrage based on race, color, or previous condition of servitude.
- _____ Indictments; due process; self-incrimination; double jeopardy, and rules for Eminent domain
- _____ Term commencements for Congress (January 3) and the President (January 20). This amendment is also known as the “lame duck amendment”.
- _____ Presidential succession
- _____ Freedom of religion, of speech, of the press, to assemble, and to petition
- _____ Rights to a fair and speedy public trial, to notice of accusations, to confront the Accuser, to subpoenas, to counsel
- _____ Immunity of states from suits from out-of-state citizens and foreigners not living within the state borders. Lays the foundation for sovereign immunity
- _____ Voting age nationally established at 18
- _____ Interdiction of unreasonable searches and seizures; search warrant is required to search persons or property
- _____ Unenumerated rights
- _____ Defines citizenship and deals with post-Civil-War issues
- _____ Federal recognition of women’s suffrage
- _____ Prohibition of the restriction of voting rights due to the non-payment of poll taxes
- _____ Variance of congressional compensation
- _____ Limits the president to two terms
- _____ No quartering of soldiers in private houses during peacetime. In a time of war, Congress can pass a law stating that soldiers should be quartered.
- _____ Right to trial by jury in civil cases
- _____ Revises presidential election procedures
- _____ Direct election of senators
- _____ Abolishes slavery and involuntary servitude, except as punishment for a crime.
- _____ Repeals the Eighteenth Amendment
- _____ Representation of Washington, D.C. in the Electoral College
- _____ No excessive bail or fines, or cruel and unusual punishment
- _____ Enumerates the right to keep and bear arms
- _____ Allows federal income tax
- _____ Prohibition of alcohol (*Repealed by Twenty-first Amendment*)
